

NATIONAL SOCIAL HOUSING SAFETY AND COMPLIANCE WEEK

SURVEY PRIZE DRAW TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The National Social Housing Safety & Compliance Week survey prize draw (the "Prize Draw") is open to certain residents of the United Kingdom aged 18 and over. The Prize Draw is void where prohibited by law. Failure to comply with any part of this clause will disqualify the respective entry from the contest.
2. The Prize Draw is not open to employees or agencies of Association of Safety and Compliance Professionals Limited ("ASCP" or the "Promoter"), their group companies, their agencies, family members or anyone else connected to the Prize Draw.

ASCP reserves the right at its sole discretion to disqualify any individual found to be attempting to circumvent this clause by tampering with the operation of the contest (including not limited to) setting up multiple accounts, using multiple identities or to be acting in any manner deemed by the promoter to be in violation of these terms and conditions; or to be acting in any manner deemed by the promoter to be disruptive.

9. In the event of unforeseen circumstances beyond the ASCP's reasonable control, the ASCP reserves the right to change the dates of the Prize and substitute with other dates, cancel, terminate, modify or

suspend the contest or these terms and conditions, either in whole or in part, with or without a reasonable notice to the Entrants. The prize: 3 places, for one organisation, on the Level 2 Award in Asset and Building Compliance Awareness qualification.
