Generic Emergency Response Plan



Ensure that Abri has the processes in place to respond to and recover from emergencies that exist within its communities.



Sets out the information, procedures, and actions to be taken to ensure an effective, flexible, and timely response by Abri to any major incident or emergency in our communities.



Ensure a rapid, efficient, and co-ordinated mobilisation and direction of responding colleagues and resources during an emergency.



It covers emergencies within all communities that Abri serves and will frequently include working in partnership with Civil Contingencies Act responders.



Generic Emergency Response Plan



Validate the Generic Emergency Response Plan by exercising Abri's response to a major incident in our community



Deliver a response to an incident and allow colleagues to experience elements of response and recovery



Help prepare as best we can
